INFORMATION

The name of the tool is Element Locator. It is a chrome extension. At this location, <https://chrome.google.com/webstore/detail/element-locator/pldlfgnilfdheajekfphjkjeooignhkc?hl=en> <-- double click

you can add this extension to your Chrome browser.

Once added to your Chrome extensions, you can activate it by selecting it from the extensions icon pull down menu in the top right bar of your Chrome browser, or right-click on any browser page object and select option "Turn on elements locator".

There is a button to turn it in the ON or OFF position after the tool displays.

When you right-click on a page object, there is an option "Turn on elements locator" which adds an entry to the tool's list or click on the object. You can see the number increment on the tool icon if you enable it. The list entry will have XPATH and CSS Selector values. It allows you to copy the value to the clipboard and past it into your Robot Framework code. This is immensely helpful.
