- 8. Leave the application and browser

Functional Test Requirements

- 1. Divide the browser and variable test controls into separate RF resource files for reusability.
- 2. Define primary test functions into a separate resource file.
- 3. Define 3 test cases in the test case file.
- 4. Setup existence tests for a set of page objects.

Acceptance Test Requirements

- 1. Verify browser test scenarios Chrome and Firefox.
- 2. Verify tests for the following scenarios.
 - a. Verify customer account setup and use.
 - b. Verify visitor Search functionality and filter pulldown buttons on results page.
 - c. Verify visitor bar links navigation.

Acceptance Test Change Requirements

1. Redesign Keyword-driven tests into Data-driven tests. Keywords are still in use but not the driver.

- 2. Conduct multi-browser tests Chrome and Firefox. The driver is in the spreadsheet too.
- 3. Conduct end-to-end tests for the following processes.
 - a) Create and conduct test cases for Header Bar Links on home page
 - b) Create and conduct test cases for Search function and pulldown buttons on results page
